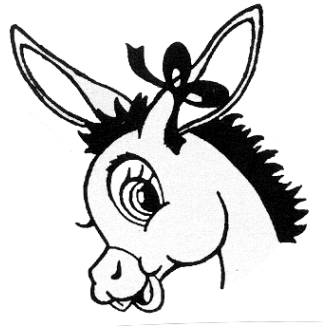

Poll Site Changes

Jerusalem 1 has been moved from the Branchport Firehouse to the Keuka Park Firehouse on Assembly Ave.

Jerusalem 4 has been moved from the Keuka Business Park to the Keuka Park Firehouse on Assembly Ave.

Milo 1 & 2 have been moved from the County Auditorium to the Cooperative Extension Conference Room on the first floor of the County Office Building.

Milo 3, 5, & 6 have been moved from the Penn Yan Village Hall to St. Paul's Lutheran Church on Hamilton St. (Inspector parking across the street)

Commissioners Have Been Busy –

Yates County is one of the counties that has been certified as ready to proceed with using the ImageCast voting system and that is a major achievement.

A very important effort underway is assuring that every polling place has reliable telephone service for the Inspectors on Election Day

The Commissioners have also been working with the Emergency Management department to develop Evacuation Plans that are specific to each polling location. One aspect that had not received enough attention is making sure all voters are out of the building, especially the bathrooms!

BMD Inspectors

We plan to eventually have all Inspectors trained to assist voters with the Ballot Marking Device. This year the BMD Class will be for people who have not worked with the BMD. For the elections a mix of newly trained BMD inspectors and those trained in past years will be assigned to the ImageCast.

Inspectors who have been trained previously on the BMD, are encouraged to stop by the office to review the BMD procedures so they don't completely forget the process.

August Training Class

A class for Inspectors is scheduled for Monday, August 16th from 9:30 until 1:30 in the County Auditorium for the folk who were unable to attend the classes in the spring. It is also open to new inspectors if you know anyone who is interested.

Because the BOE Budget is very tight and no one wants to see taxes increase, we are asking you to come to training only if you are available to work **BOTH** elections –

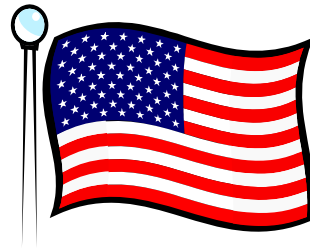


Primary - September 14th

Remember that voters who have a new address within the District, must be entered on the Challenge Report.
