Payment for Inspectors

As we prepare this newsletter, we do not know if there will be a Special Election for Congress in the 29th District. Obviously, if one is called we'll need your help!

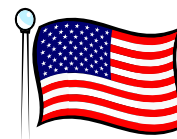
Just some "Tibbits"

10 Steps if Issuing an Affidavit Ballot

1. Active & Inactive Lists
2. Street Finder
3. Notice to Voters
4. Fill out both sides of envelope completely
5. Chair review and sign
6. Issue ballot
7. Return Envelope to voter
8. Instruct voter to seal the voted ballot inside and return
9. Store in Red Affidavit Bag
10. Enter on the Challenge Report

The Zero Tape and the Results tape have replaced the Canvass sheet but you will have a Tally Sheet Summary for recording the tally of Emergency Ballots and Write-in Votes. We'll cover this at training so do not fret!
