**INTER-OFFICE MEMO**

**RE: Household Hazardous Waste Day Event to be held August 28<sup>th</sup>.**

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RFP's were sent out last month to the following companies for pricing and dates:

- Environmental Protection Service
- Clean Management Environmental Group
- MXI Environmental
- E Waste +
- Sun Environmental Corporation

The only company to respond for the electronics was E Waste+, which we used them at the 2019 event. The only company to respond for the hazardous waste was MXI Environmental which is a company out of Pennsylvania that Schuylers County uses.

To be able to give you an exact price for the event is difficult as E Waste+ is based on tonnage. However, they are charging an additional \$5.00 for a microwave now. At the event in 2019 their bill was \$10,000 and we had approximately 390 participants.

MXI has given me a flat price of \$15,999 for 250 vehicles, there will be an extra charge from them if we go over that.

Both companies bring their own personnel for unloading but I would ask for 4 volunteers to work with me again and have asked Craig for someone from Highway in case a fork lift is needed and so the garage can be opened for bathroom use. This seemed to work out pretty good the last time.

The event will be on August 28<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 until noon. I have already spoken with Kristen VanHorn in Schuylers County to let her know the day and Schuylers County will be contributing \$4,500 so that Schuylers County resident can also participate.

I will be working on the registration form, ad, permits with DEC and obtain state approval in coming months.
