**DESIGNATE DEPUTY HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT AS THE
RESPONSIBLE LOCAL OFFICIAL (RLO) FOR PURPOSES OF THE NYSDOT'S EBO
SOFTWARE**

WHEREAS, by this Resolution the Yates County Legislature designates Craig Prior, Yates County Deputy Highway Superintendent, as the County's Responsible Local Official (RLO) for purposes of the NYS Department of Transportation's Equitable Business Opportunities software (EBO), which streamlines and reduces the efforts required by the construction industry to satisfy civil rights reporting requirements; and

WHEREAS, in his position as Yates County Deputy Highway Superintendent, Craig Prior has frequent contact with NYS Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) personnel thereby making him the most appropriate County employee to oversee NYSDOT's EBO software;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Yates County Legislature designates responsibility as the Responsible Local Official for purposes of NYSDOT's EBO software to Craig Prior; and be it further

RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be sent to the Yates County Highway Department and the New York State Department of Transportation.

AUTHORIZE LEGISLATURE CHAIRMAN TO SIGN 2020 MOWING CONTRACTS

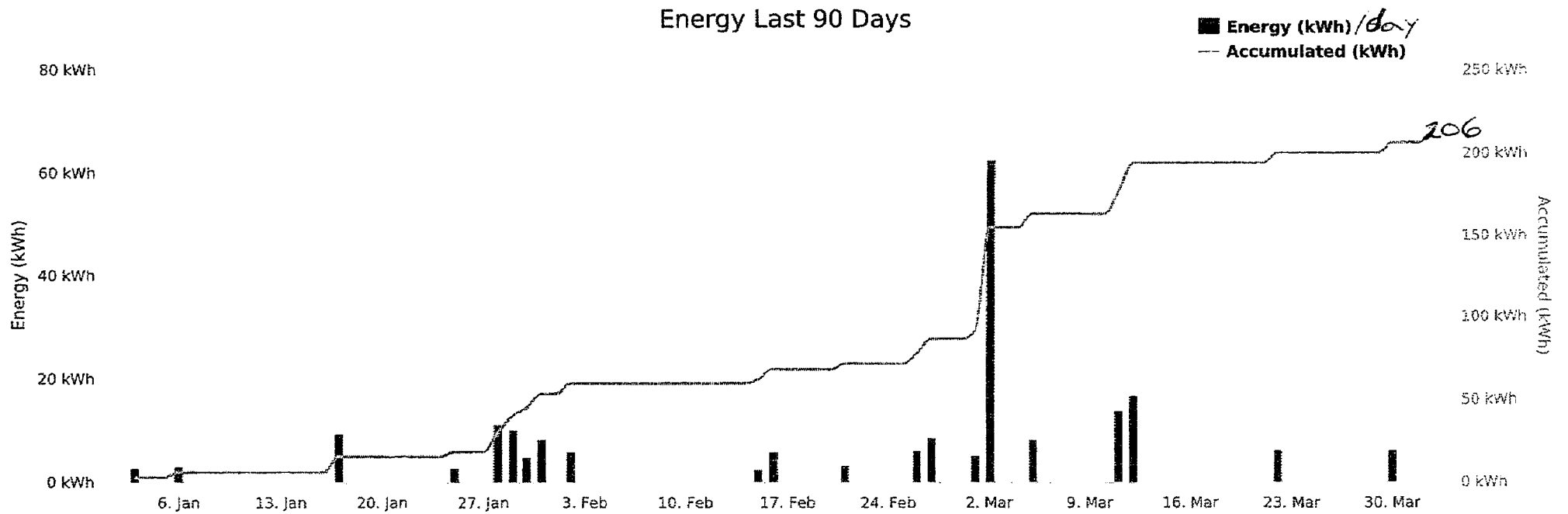
