Sealed bids for the **Terminal Apron Rehabilitation** will be received by Yates County Clerk of the Legislature (Attn: Emilee Miller), at 417 Liberty Street, Penn Yan, New York 14527 on **April 17 at 2:00 PM** local time, at which time and place all bids shall be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids submitted after this time shall not be accepted. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked, **"Sealed Bid: Terminal Apron Rehabilitation , at Penn Yan - Yates County Airport."**

The **Base Bid** project generally consists of milling existing asphalt pavement and placing 2" of new asphalt as well as new pavement markings. Contractors must be bonded and insured to the level indicated in the contract. Prevailing wage rates apply. A Federal Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal is included in the project. The owner is sales tax exempt.
