I have received an e-mail request from the Administrator of Clinton Crest Manor requesting that the County consider allocating funds to the Manor.

- Airport –
 - Funds received by the county from NYSDOT for the final payment for the Bath Road Sewer Project have been forwarded to the Town of Milo. Consultant is working on closeout paperwork.
 - \$59,000 (ARPA) grant for additional COVID relief funds has been executed.
 - The heavy rain on August 17 and 18 damaged the inadvertent entry fence. Highway has agreed to assist with temporary repairs. Our consultant will prepare specifications for brush/tree removal and fence relocation to reduce the chance that this situation will reoccur.

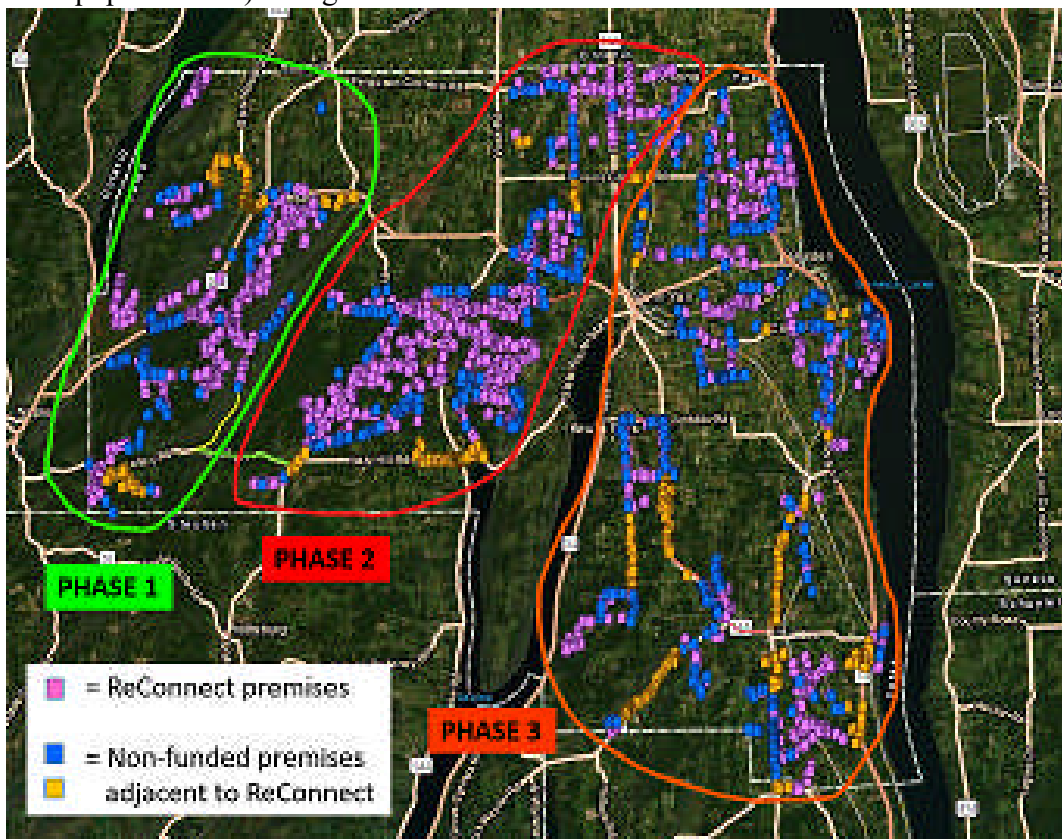

**Yates County Broadband Update – Marian Walrath/Dan Long
Finance Committee 9/7/2021**

1. **ReConnect 1 Services Agreement with Empire Access**
 - a. Agreement still out for review and approval by USDA/RUS → backlog.
2. **ReConnect 1 Engineering**
 - a. The executed RUS 217 contract has been reviewed and approved by RUS.
 - b. The plan is to complete the Plans and Specifications and the construction bid process in phases. Phase 1 also includes the backbone network which connects all areas. The surveying/fielding work is completed for the backbone and is proceeding for the distribution network in Middlesex/Italy. Location of POP's (point of presence equipment huts) are agreed to with Middlesex and Dundee.



3. **ReConnect 1 Construction**
 - a. The goal is to start Phase I construction in 2021 a part of a more detailed 3-year plan. We are firming up plans to pre-order longer lead-times items like fiber and equipment.
 - b. We are working on potential pole application and NYS DOT ROW “bottleneck” processes. There was a productive meeting with NYSEG representatives where we learned of the “one-touch” process aimed at shortening the application/Make-Ready lead-time. We are investigating the cost and agreement needed to engage a required 3rd party engineering firm (LaBella Associates) to lead the “one-touch” process. We also had a productive meeting with Senator O’Mara. We agreed to combine forces supporting passage of NYS Bill A06538A – exempting municipalities and non-profits from the new NYS DOT ROW fees. Nonie Flynn will also champion this at the upcoming NYSAC meeting. Pole Attachment status:

**ENTER INTO A POLE ATTACHMENT AGREEMENT WITH FRONTIER
COMMUNICATIONS**

WHEREAS, the County of Yates (hereinafter referred to as the “County”) wishes to license for its own use, the right to attach and maintain its telecommunications cables, equipment, facilities and attachments with necessary guys and appurtenances on poles owned by Frontier Communications (hereinafter referred to as “Frontier”); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that upon the approval of the County Attorney, the Chairman of the Legislature is authorized to execute on behalf of Yates County a Pole Attachment Agreement with Frontier concerning the County’s right, by way of license, to attach and maintain its telecommunications cables, equipment, facilities and attachments with necessary guys and appurtenances on poles owned by Frontier; and be it further

RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be provided to the Yates County Administrator, Yates County Planner and Frontier Communications.

**ENTER INTO A POLE ATTACHMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE VILLAGE OF
PENN YAN**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that upon the approval of the County Attorney, the Chairman of the Legislature is authorized to execute on behalf of Yates County a Pole Attachment Agreement with the Village concerning the County’s right, by way of license, to attach and maintain its telecommunications cables, equipment, facilities and attachments with necessary guys and appurtenances on poles owned by the Village; and be it further

Transportation

YTS will be providing an update on Public Transportation during the pandemic at the legislative session.

Yates County Planning Board

7 referrals were reviewed by the Board (3-Benton, 2-Penn Yan, 1-Milo, 1-Rushville) all found to have no county-wide impact. Tom Fulkrod, CEO of Benton has been continuing his work in bringing Special Use Permit applications previously overlooked in order to increase zoning compliance in the Town. We still seek appointments for the Village of Dresden and an at-large member for the Board.

Funding for Natural and Recreational Resources

Recipients of the 2021 awards are providing updates to their projects. The Village of Dresden has near completed their beach access project despite the weather, FL Museum and the Izzak Walton League are working on completing their projects this Fall, HWS/Town of Geneva is working with Friends of the Outlet on further trail improvements and enhancement of water quality by utilizing wetlands that have been established in the channel by Spring 2022. The NY Grape Foundation is completing their program for sustainable vineyard certification by October.

GIS

GeoCove is continuing to work on a technical solution for laserfiche and the survey links to the parcel maps. A separate application for Elections and information related to that department should be up by the time of the Finance Committee. GeoCove has offered to provide a presentation of the work performed to date and some of the efforts ongoing at the October session.

Other Items:

ReConnect Grant: Marian Walrath, Grant Specialist for the Broadband Committee will update the Finance Committee on the joint efforts of grant applications, communicating with fellow Counties that have received Round 2 awards and future Broadband efforts.

Resolution to authorize the Chairman to sign MOU's related to the ReConnect project is attached.

Re: Treasurer's Office Report for August 2021

2021 Tax Advertising – On July 31st, 2021, 446 courtesy letters were sent to owners of parcels with outstanding 2021 taxes due to Yates County. The number of letters mailed decreased by 88 in comparison to 2020. As of September 1, 2021 there are 271 parcels with 2021 taxes due. This figure is also down in comparison to last year when 346 parcels remained owing 2020 taxes.

A list of delinquent tax parcels will be listed in local newspapers in September and the cost of \$4.00 will be added to their tax bill.

Collection of 2018 and 2019 Taxes – As of August 31, 2021, there are 7 parcels with remaining 2018 taxes due and 11 parcels with remaining 2019 taxes due, a listing of which has been provided with this report. The Treasurer's office will be collecting on 2018 and 2019 taxes through January 1, 2022.
