Minutes of the December meeting were approved as presented.

HIGHWAY: Doug Rapalee

Doug reported that the Central Garage mileage for December was 3,800+. The projected delivery date for the 2022 Malibu is July 2023 and the projected delivery date for the 2022 Equinox is May 2023.

Doug provided updates regarding the Building Project, highlighting: Meetings with C & S, Fuel Island & Distribution, C & S Design, Closing on properties, & the NYSEG Natural Gas Service Design.

Doug reported that in regards to the FEMA Flood Reimbursement the Class C costs are still pending, no update.

Doug reviewed the status of his 2022 Goals and his proposed 2023 Goals.

Doug reported that they have been working on new driveways, cutting and removal of trees and brush, hauling of 1A stone for 2023 chip seal, and cleaning under guide rails.

Doug reviewed the ditching, bridges, and culverts they are working on.

Doug reported that they were out for snow 11 days in December. There was a Snow Watch meeting with the Town Highway Superintendent's was held December 20th. The County snow plow equipment rental rates have been updated.

Doug reviewed updates in regards to road machinery, highlighting: NYS Vehicle Inspections, 2022 ¾ Ton Pick-up, and the 2022 Snow Plow Truck.

Doug reported that the meter replacements, temp-press parts for the landfill should be delivered in early January. They continue to maintain the trees along the perimeter fence.
