

SPECIAL SESSION – MONDAY, MARCH 4, 2019

The Yates County Legislature met in special session, Monday, March 4, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. with Chairman Paddock presiding and Legislator Bronson absent.

Mrs. Church moved to enter into executive session to discuss collective bargaining negotiations with Council 82 Law Enforcement with members of the Legislature, the Sheriff, the Undersheriff, the Personnel Officer, the Acting County Administrator and the County's Labor Attorney in attendance by phone, seconded by Mrs. Percy.

**RATIFYING LABOR AGREEMENT WITH COUNCIL 82
(DEPUTY SHERIFFS UNIT)**

WHEREAS, the collective bargaining teams for the County of Yates, the Yates County Sheriff and the Law Enforcement Officers Union, AFSCME Council 82 have concluded negotiations for a successor collective bargaining agreement covering the period of January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2024 for the deputy sheriffs bargaining unit,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Yates County Legislature hereby ratifies said agreement and authorizes the expenditure of the necessary funds therefor, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Yates County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of the County, and be it further

RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be given to the Sheriff, the Council 82 Unit President, the Acting County Administrator and the County's Labor Attorney.
