Ron reviewed how recently passed legislation is going to affect the agency.

Ron reviewed the Revenue Appropriations/Over Time/SWEAP reports. Ron explained that due to staff shortages in the jail the over time is up.

Ron reported he has been approved by DCJS-OPS to do a part time corrections training school.

Ron reported the Annual NYSSI K9 seminar will be April 28<sup>th</sup> through May 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Showboat Motel.

Ron reported the Take-Back Drug event will be April 28<sup>th</sup> at the back of the County Courthouse, with DEA.

Ron reported the Yates County Sheriff Office members attended an appreciation dinner by the Elks Club "Just Say No" to drugs group which was held on March 21<sup>st</sup>. Ron thanked the Elks for 30 years of providing this program.

Ron reported he will be meeting with the Keuka Lake Assoc. Navigation Safety Committee on April 3<sup>rd</sup> in Hammondspport for this season of boating. Discussion will be on environmental and related navigation law issues.
