Highway – Craig Prior

Craig updated the Committee on Central Garage activities. The 2021 Chrysler Van is now in service. The 2018 Dodge Van will be posted on Auctions International and Craig is still waiting for the 2021 Chevrolet Malibu.

Craig reported all open positions have been filled.

Craig reported on the increase in funding for CHIPS, PAVE-NY and EWR.

Craig reported crews have been doing ditch maintenance on various roads. Also, the mowing of road sides will begin in May.

Craig reported the milling of the capital projects started today and the hot mix contractor will begin on May 24th.
