

## **PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE**

### **PARKING AT COB** – Dan Banach

Dan explained that on the first Monday of each month the parking is at a premium and he would like to not schedule the auditorium on that Monday. The consensus of the Committee was to leave as is.

### **SOLID WASTE** – Connie Hayes

Connie explained the issue of charging for recyclables is still going on. The haulers would like to split out the cost for recycling on customer bills to be able to show transparency. The consensus of the Committee was leave things the way they are and if the haulers need additional funds to cover the recycling costs, they should raise their rates.

Rick Willson brought up the issue of a Solid Waste Plan and that the County should be putting one together. Connie explained that the Committee had charged her with the Solid Waste Plan but she has not had time to work on it.

### **HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT** – Craig Prior

Craig reviewed the resolutions that would be needed. The committee approved.

- Resolution – Authorize Chair to sign Mowing Agreements
- Resolution – Acquire property for William St. Bridge

Craig reported on Central Garage. So far the revenue that has been collected is approximately \$19,000 and \$30,000 was budgeted for the year.

Craig reported the Capital Plan that was submitted for Highway for next year included two new sanders. Craig would like to purchase them this year. The Committee agreed.

### **BUILDINGS & GROUNDS** - Joe Reed

Joe reviewed the Weights & Measures report.

Joe reported on the Clean Energy Communities. The County Attorney is preparing an agreement in regards to the electric vehicle charging station and horse shelter.

Joe reviewed the following resolutions that would be needed. The Committee approved.

- Authorize The Chairman To Sign An Agreement With Penn Yan Public Library Concerning Electric Vehicle Charging Station and Horse Shelter Parking Space
- Grant Unpaid Leave Of Absence (Wakeman)
- Authorize The Designation Of No Trespass Areas And The Posting Of No Trespassing Signs On Such Areas

Joe reported the monthly inspections were done on the FM 200 system checks and the annual preventative maintenance on the UPS at the Public Safety Building.

Joe reported the County Attorney is reviewing RFP language options for Solar on the Landfill.

Joe reported Buildings and Grounds has installed the sixth shower. There is one left to go.

Joe reported summer hours started today. The evening crew will be working from noon to 8:30. If there is anyone still in the building they will make sure the doors are secure.
