Local Law No. 3-1971 paragraphs numbered "2", "3", "4", "5", "6", "7", "8", "9", "10", and "11" are hereby amended to read as follows:

2. That as of January 1, 1972, a new board shall be established in place and stead of the Board of Supervisors and shall be known as the Yates County Legislature. That the Yates County Legislature shall have the same powers and duties as the Board of Supervisors had prior to January 1, 1972 and all the powers and duties and obligations granted and imposed on the Board of Supervisors by the County Law, the General Municipal Law, the Local Finance Law, the Town Law and all other statutory laws relating to a Board of Supervisors. The Yates County Legislature shall have the same offices as the previous Board of Supervisors, and all of the rules and regulations and procedures heretofore adopted by the Board of Supervisors and the Legislative Board of the County of Yates shall continue by the Yates County Legislature until changed or amended by said Yates County Legislature.

3. There shall be fourteen (14) members of the Yates County Legislature who shall be elected to said Legislature by the registered voters of the County of Yates at a general election to be held in November 1983.

4. That for the purpose of electing the members of said Legislature, the County of Yates is hereby divided into four (4) election districts as follows:

District No. 1: Towns of Italy, Jerusalem and Middlesex

District No. 2: Towns of Benton, Potter and Torrey

District No. 3: Election Districts numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6
of the Town of Milo

District No. 4: Towns of Barrington and Starkey and election district
number 7 of the Town of Milo

5. Each of said four (4) districts shall elect the following numbers
of members to said Yates County Legislature, as hereinafter provided:

District No. 1: Four members

District No. 2: Three members

District No. 3: Four members

District No. 4: Three members

6. Each member of the Yates County Legislature shall have one vote in
respect to all procedures to be voted on by the members of the Yates County
Legislature.

7. That the members of the Yates County Legislature shall be elected
for a term of two (2) years thereafter by the registered voters of the County
of Yates.

8. Every member of the Yates County Legislature shall, at the time of
his election and throughout his term of office, be a registered voter of his
district.

9. The Town Supervisor of any town in Yates County and the Mayor
of any incorporated village in Yates County and members of the legislative
bodies of towns or villages, who reside in the County, shall be eligible to
be elected as County Legislators.

10. That as to all matters and all procedures to be voted on by the
members of the Yates County Legislature, each member shall have one vote.

11. That all applicable provisions of the Election Law which provides
for the method and procedure for the nomination and election for County officers,
shall apply to the Yates County Legislature and further, that each member shall
be nominated and elected in the respective district which he would represent if
elected.

12. This Local Law will take effect on the date it is duly filed
in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York and in accordance
with the applicable provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Laws of the State of
New York.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)
