

ENHANCED ID/LICENSE AND REAL ID

There are questions involving the required documentation for issuance and what the difference is between these documents.

The REAL ID

This document is accepted for boarding a domestic flight (inside the U.S.)

For entrance to a federal building

There is no additional fee.

The ENHANCED LICENSE/ID

This document is available to U.S. Citizens only

It is accepted for boarding a domestic flight (inside the U.S.)

For entrance to a federal building

It is accepted at U.S. Land/Sea Border Crossings – If you travel by land or by sea this document will allow you to cross into Canada, Mexico and some of the islands below the U.S.

There is an additional fee of \$30.00

The Enhanced document **will not** be replaced by the REAL ID

Proof of U.S. citizenship or lawful status is required for both documents

Eligible for Enhanced or REAL ID: U.S. Passport or Passport Card, Certificate of Naturalization or Citizenship, U.S. Birth Certificate **must be issued by the Bureau of Vital Statistics** (Original or Certified) or an Original or certified copy of U.S. Consular Report of Birth Abroad.

These items will **also** be accepted for **REAL ID** only: Foreign Passport , Permanent Resident Card I-551 or Employment Authorization Document accompanied by documentation approved by Department of Homeland Security (e.g., I-797) that specifically states valid U.S. lawful status defined by 6 C.F.R. 37.3.

Social Security Card is required on an original document. If this is an **upgrade** from a regular license or ID a W-2 or Federal or NYS Income Tax or Earning Statement 1099 will be accepted if the social security card is not available

Full legal name: If your name has changed due to marriage, divorce, or legal name change you must bring original or certified copies documenting the change (marriage certificate, divorce decree, court issued documents). If your name has changed multiple times, you must bring multiple documents that link all names.

Proof of address: Each document must show your current address in New York State. An address with a P.O. Box is not acceptable. If your license is correct on your license with a street address bring one other proof of your physical address. Example: Utility Bill, Bank Statement, Property Taxes, W-2.
