

BUS GARAGE HELPER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:

An incumbent in this class is responsible for the performance of unskilled work in the repair and maintenance of automotive equipment. Incumbent may independently perform minor repair work but usually work is performed under direct supervision of a higher level mechanic. Incumbent spends the majority of time washing buses. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative Only)

- Washes buses;
- Replaces worn or faulty parts, including gaskets, spark plugs, windshield wipers and lightbulbs;
- Washes, greases and changes oil in automotive equipment;
- Pumps gasoline;
- May occasionally drive school buses.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

- Working knowledge of the common practices, tools, terminology and safety precautions associated with the automotive mechanics trade;
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions;
- Physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

None are required.
