

## SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This work consists primarily of routine patrol tasks. Has personal responsibility in an assigned district during a specific period for the policing of cars in the school district to protect the lives of school children. There is considerable independent responsibility for the exercise of sound judgment in emergencies. However, ordinary procedures and special assignments are carried out. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative only)

Patrols a specific district or beat on foot;  
Directs traffic;  
Takes children safely across the highway;  
Maintains order;  
Makes daily reports of activities.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES & PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Good social and general intelligence; ability to be courteous yet firm with the public; good knowledge of first aid methods; good judgment; good powers of observation and memory; excellent moral character; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from high school or a high school equivalency diploma; or any equivalent combination OF experience and training sufficient to indicate ability to do the work.
